

Daytona Metropolitan Bridge Club Policy for Assistance in Finding Partners

- 1. Implement a sign-up sheet on bulletin board that players can use who need a partner. Sheet should include their name, phone number to contact, and date of game.**
- 2. Create a listing of members who are willing to play on short notice. Include name, phone number, and days when generally available. These members would receive a “free play” if they play when called. Post this listing behind desk (and on bulletin board?).**
- 3. Directors will no longer be responsible for obtaining partners for members. If a member is in need of a partner and was not able to get one via listing their name on the bulletin board, the listing of members willing to play on short notice should be made available to them to call directly. If, however, a “new person” (someone in town for a short period or one who is new to the Club) requests a partner, the director for the requested game should make every effort to obtain a partner for that person, but no guarantees should be made. The director who first took the request should promptly forward the information to the director in charge of the requested game.**
- 4. The website, if it has not already been changed, should no longer state that a partner will be guaranteed for anyone requesting one. The website should merely state that one may request a partner.**
